

# HELP YOUR CHILD STAY SAFE NEAR TRAFFIC

# Teach your child to obey all traffic signs and signals

Steady White Light	K	<ul> <li>This sign means you may walk. However, first you should:</li> <li>Look to the left, right and left again.</li> <li>Watch for turning cars.</li> <li>When it is safe, leave the curb and cross the street.</li> <li>Keep looking for cars as you cross.</li> </ul>
Flashing Light		<ul> <li>When this sign is flashing use caution.</li> <li>If you are in the street, finish crossing the street.</li> <li>If you have NOT started crossing the street, stay on the curb.</li> <li>If a countdown timer is present, it will display the number of seconds remaining to finish crossing the street.</li> </ul>
Steady Light	STEADY	<ul> <li>When this sign is steady you should WAIT.</li> <li>Stay on the curb.</li> <li>If a button is provided, push the button and wait for the "WALK" signal.</li> </ul>
<u>Guidelines</u>	for Pedestrian Safety	

## Be sure your child knows:

- DO NOT dart out into the street. They should always use the crosswalk or cross at the corner.
- Always obey the crossing guards and follow their directions. Use designated school walking routes.
- Always walk on the sidewalk. If there is no sidewalk, always walk facing traffic as close to the left as possible.
- If there are parked cars or their view is blocked, they should move to where they can see approaching traffic.
- Look for signs that a car is about to move (rear lights, exhaust smoke, sound of motor, wheels turning, etc.).
- Make eye contact with each driver before they cross in front of a car.
- Find safe play areas away from streets, driveways or parking lots.
