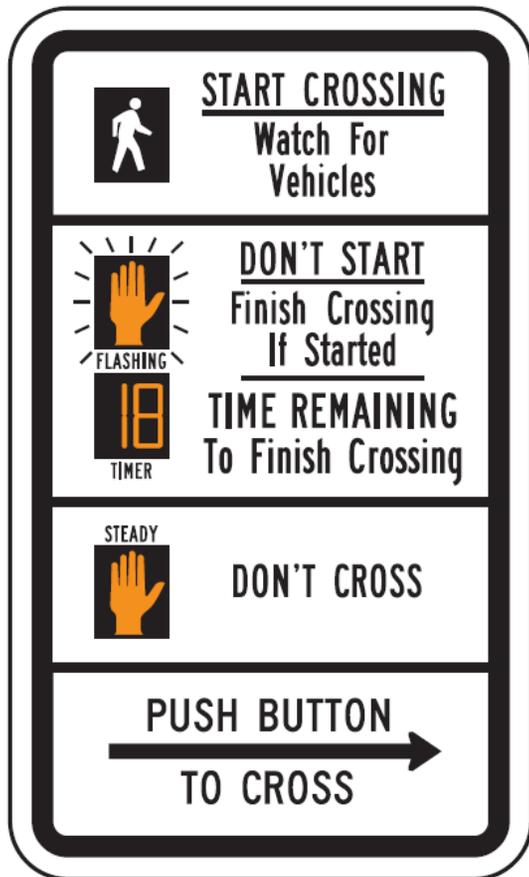

The Facts About Pedestrian Crossing Signals

Steady White Light



This sign means you may walk. However, first you should:

- ◆ Look to the left, right and left again.
- ◆ Watch for turning cars.
- ◆ When it is safe, leave the curb and cross the street.
- ◆ Keep looking for cars as you cross.

Flashing Light



When this sign is flashing use caution.

- ◆ If you are in the street, finish crossing the street.
- ◆ If you have **NOT** started crossing the street, stay on the curb.
- ◆ If a countdown timer is present, it will display the number of seconds remaining to finish crossing the street.

Steady Light



When this sign is steady you should WAIT.

- ◆ Stay on the curb.
- ◆ If a button is provided, push the button and wait for the "WALK" signal.

Guidelines for Pedestrian Safety

- ◆ Always walk on the sidewalk. If there is no sidewalk, **always walk facing traffic as close to the left as possible.**
- ◆ Use the crosswalk or cross at the corner. Do not cross the street midblock or from between parked cars.
- ◆ **Always obey the crossing guards and follow their directions. Use designated school walking routes.**
- ◆ Look for signs that a car is about to move (rear lights, exhaust smoke, sound of motor, wheels turning, etc.).
- ◆ Make eye contact with each driver before you cross the street in front of a car.
- ◆ Find locations away from traffic (park, playground, yard) for outdoor games and sports.

Remember, you are a role model for others. Set a good example.
